

## LWML Convention Kansas District – Convention Banner Information

The 2020 LWML Convention will be in Topeka, Kansas April 17-19. The theme verse for the convention is Hebrews 12:2 “looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God.” Each zone is encouraged to bring their own banner to the convention to add color and meaning to the event.

Banner specifications:

- Finished banner size is to be 3' x 5' - although added fringe may be longer.
- Banners should be based on the convention theme: “Be Thou My Vision” and, if you desire, may contain the convention logo.
- Your Zone’s name MUST be on the front of the banner. You may abbreviate your zone name and can use any size of letters you desire. In addition, to help the host committee identify your banner, please include a small tag with your zone name on the backside of the banner.
- Place a ribbon that is at least 8 inches long about 8 inches from the bottom of the back of the banner which will be used to tie the banner and keep it from swinging.
- Please attach the banner to a 1” dowel with a screw eye on each end. Secure at least 8mm or quarter inch cording through each of the screw eyes, laying the cord flat along the dowel and knotting it on the outside of each screw. Be sure to attach cord tightly as it will stretch as the banner hangs.
- Stands and poles for the banners are provided by the host committee. A room for your banner will be provided at the convention prior to the opening session.
- The banner committee will have some supplies on hand for repairs such as glue, pins, thread, needles, an iron, and an ironing board.

Please email a picture of your zone banner along with a short (less than 1/4 page) description of your banner to President Brenda Piester ([bjpiester@gmail.com](mailto:bjpiester@gmail.com)).

Your description should include the name(s) of your designer along with those that assisted in making the banner, an explanation of your banner and how it ties into our theme verse: Be Thou My Vision.

Brenda would appreciate the picture and information as soon as you have it completed but at least by February 15th.

You will receive more information later with location and times for bringing the banners to the convention.
