### LUTHERAN BRAILLE WORKERS - \$100,000

The mission of Lutheran Braille Workers (LBW) is to passionately reach out to people who are blind and visually impaired with the Good News of their Savior, Jesus Christ. There are over 36 million people in the world who are blind or visually impaired, with an estimate of over 94 percent of that population being unchurched. Many have not had access to reading the Word of Good by themselves.

New technology now exists that makes the development of braille materials into additional languages easier. Purchases of the new, Puma plate embossing device, is critical to meet the demand of producing the Bible and other materials.

The saving news of God's grace can then be spread to more people throughout the world. Funds from this mission grant will help LBW purchase the machine and pay for shipping, installation, and staff training.


