Activities of the Endowment Committee Coordinator to the Primary Focus Areas:

PROCLAIMING CHRIST

• Follow the guidance of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) and LWML Gifts of Love Ministry to ensure that we are investing in ways that are in line with our doctrine and Synod's direction.

SUPPORTING MISSIONS

- Promote the LWML Gifts of Love Ministry through Kansas *Sonshine* articles to our district members so that they know the options they have to support missions even after they have been called home to heaven.
- In collaboration with the Executive Committee, the Endowment Committee voted to approve a revision to the Gift Acceptance Policy allowing for undesignated cash gifts of \$500 or less be deposited to the God's Gracious Gift Fund account.
