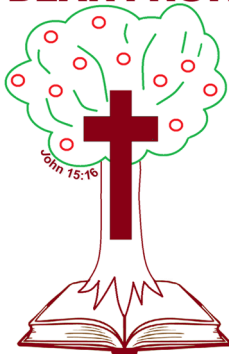

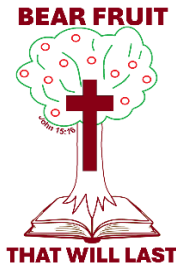

Light of the World, Lutheran Church Plant

Rev. John Kastner, Pastor of Light of the World Lutheran Church, De Soto, Kansas

All of our churches have a beginning. Some might be old enough there's no one around to remember the beginning. This session will show what it takes to begin a new church today — both the blessings and the difficulties. Light of the World in De Soto, Kansas, has labored to spread God's Word and establish a congregation through the work, not only of those with boots on the ground, but also of those across Kansas who have worked to support it. With the LWML's help, the Word of God has been spread and handed down for all who need to hear it.

Campus Ministry in the LCMS Kansas District

Rev. Sean Kilgo, Campus Ministry Coordinator for LCMS Kansas District

What goes on in the campus ministry world? How can you be involved in supporting our students as they transition into adulthood and maturity? What can be done to encourage our Lutheran students to remain faithful, as well as reach out to students currently outside the Lutheran church? Pr. Sean Kilgo, campus pastor at the University of Kansas and Campus Ministry Coordinator for the LCMS Kansas District, will answer these questions and more in this interest session.

Lutheran Early Response Teams: What it Means to Serve

Donna Williams, District Disaster Response Coordinator, LERT Kansas District

Is Disaster Response in the Kansas District limited to only disaster events or critical incidents? This is one of the most asked questions I hear. Yes, we train to respond to these extraordinary events both locally and across the U.S. and internationally. Yes, our training makes us hyper-aware of the weather and the damage and recovery that follows our stormy seasons. The beauty of the LERT training curriculum is that it prepares us to respond with other LERT volunteers in these environments. It also equips us to partner with Christ Care groups and staff within our congregations, and gives outreach opportunities in our communities. LWML has been a valuable partner since Disaster Response became an active ministry in 2015. Our prayer is that together we can continue to grow and adapt as we respond to the needs of people who need to see Grace and Mercy in action — people Jesus puts in front of us every day.

Show up and Shut up: A Bridge to Comfort

Carol Kratzer and Comfort Dog, Keren, Lutheran Church Charities K-9 Comfort Dog Ministry®

Christian mission organizations seek to proclaim the Gospel for the sake of saving men and women, boys and girls. But how do you combat a growing repressive and renewed opposition to the Gospel? It begins by remembering and engaging God's Two Kingdom approach to the world, the culture, and the mission field. The Lutheran Center for Religious Liberty has launched the Champions Network to equip men and women to re-engage the culture not just with the Gospel, salvation evangelism, but also intentionally cultivating good government and civic responsibility. We need to cultivate a healthy relationship between Church and State, which is a Biblical teaching. If we don't, the LWML, and organizations in kind, will be criminalized. Let's talk about how to cultivate culture so that you can bear fruit for generations to come.

Banners will be displayed following the banner procession on Saturday morning.

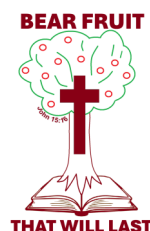
